**Old Business:** The control line circle is on hold for the moment so that we can temporarily install a Heli pad behind the pit area, behind the out house and south of the parking lot, to see how it operates away from the end of the runway. This will give us more separation between the fixed wing and rotary wing aircraft. Other clubs have used this approach to Heli flight and found out it works the best. This way there is no waiting time for airspace for the Heli and fixed wing pilots for flying. If you look at what we have at the moment when a helicopter is hovering the pilot is in danger of a fixed wing aircraft hitting them if it swings wide on approach for landing or if the Heli drifts over towards the runway and hitting the fixed wing aircraft.

**New Business:** Planning another work party for finishing the ground work for the infield grass area between the taxi ways. We will also be planning on a work party to prepare the storage container site. The date will be set up by Harry Hill so if you would like to come out and help contact Harry, his number is at the top of this newsletter. You would need to bring gardening equipment, rakes, shovels, picks; hoes etc. etc. or even just yourself as we could use the man power.

Also, we will be planning a work party for the installation of the new Helicopter training pad to the south of the parking lot behind and to the west of the outhouse.
